

Important Safety Information About Automatic Gates



WARNING: *Serious injuries can occur when automatic gates are not used properly. To help prevent injuries, read and follow safety precautions, and share this information with anyone you allow to use the gate.*

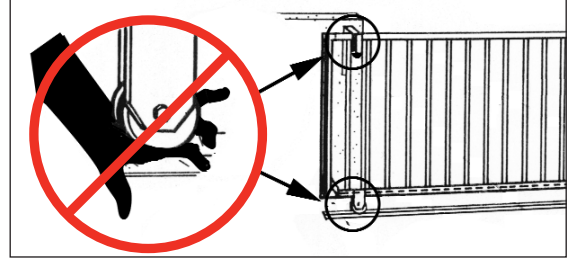
- ▶ Do not let children play on or near the gate.



- ▶ Do not reach through or lean against the gate.



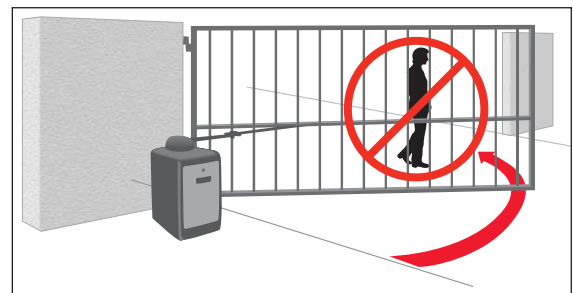
- ▶ Keep hands and feet away from rollers.



- ▶ Do not open or close the gate if anyone is near. Stay away from a moving gate. Most gates do not reverse automatically if they hit an obstacle.



- ▶ Do not let people walk near a moving or open gate. Automatic gates are designed for vehicles, not pedestrians.



- ▶ For safety and security, do not let unauthorized users operate the gate. Tell manager if the gate does not work properly or has broken or damaged parts.
